



Applications are open to all interested applicants to fill the following vacancy:

**Pilot in Command (PIC) and meets the qualifications to deputise the Flights Operations and Crew Training Manager position (Senior Person)**

The PIC's primary responsibility is to ensure the safety of the aircraft, its passengers, crew, mail, cargo.

All operational decisions made by the captain should be done with sound Crew Resource Management techniques and should be governed by the company's policy and the terms of the Air Operators Certificate. Interested candidates are required to apply for this role.

Preferable SAAB 340 rated (as per table 1) or if you are NTR you need to comply with requirements on table 2.

**Some of the Key Responsibilities, full scope presented during induction course**

1. Act as a senior company representative
2. Reports to the Flight Operations Manager (FOM)
3. Familiar with, conducting all flights in accordance with, the limitations and performance of the aircraft, as laid down in the appropriate Flight Manual, Operations Manuals and Standard Operating Procedures
4. Conduct all flights in accordance with the Operations Manuals, Tonga and International air transport legislation and with internationally accepted aviation practices and procedures
5. The in-flight simulation of emergencies while passengers and cargo are being transported onboard the aircraft
6. Operate "in a cost-effective manner equivalent with safety regulatory and passenger comfort"
